Rental Agreement

1. LEASE AND RENTAL FEE: The undersigned Customer ("Lessee") leases from Bounce On Me ("Lessor") the inflatable unit(s) listed above ("Unit") at the date and time specified above. Lessee shall pay Lessor the Rental Fee as stated above prior to receipt on the Unit.

2. DELIVERY AND TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES: Except as otherwise provided herein, all charges in delivering and pick-ups of the Unit to and from the Event Location specified above are included in the Total noted above. Lessor shall use its best efforts to deliver the Unit at the "From" time on the Event Date as stated above; however Lessor cannot guarantee that the Unit will be delivered at exactly the From time. Lessor shall not be held responsible from any claims for damages in the event that the Unit is delivered earlier or later than the "From" time. Lessee grants Lessor the right to enter the specified property for delivery and removal of Unit.

3. RULES TO FOLLOW DURING THE USE OF THE UNIT: (a) Only participants of compatible ages and sizes shall play in the Unit at the same time. Adhere to capacity requirements as posted on the Unit. (b) All participants must remove shoes, glasses, and other sharp objects before entering the Unit. (c) To avoid neck and back injuries, flips are not allowed in the Unit. In the event that the Unit is an inflatable slide, participants shall not jump from the platform onto the sliding area. (d) ADULT SUPERVISION IS ABSOLUTELY REQUIRED WHEN PARTICIPANTS ARE IN THE UNIT. THE LESSEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SUPERVISION OF THE PARTICIPANTS WHILE THEY ARE IN THE UNIT. AS THE LESSEE OF THE UNIT, THE SAFETY OF ALL PARTICIPANTS SHALL BE THE LESSEE'S SOLE RESPONSIBILITY. (e) Absolutely no "Silly String", gum, candy, drinks, food, cigarettes, confetti, or any other substances are allowed in the unit. (f) The Unit shall not be moved from the location of installation. In the event that the Unit has accidentally moved, remove all participants from the Unit and move the Unit back to the location of installation. It is the Lessee's responsibility to keep the Unit clean and free from debris. In no event shall the Unit be removed from the address specified above. (g) The anchoring system (stakes or sandbags) shall not be altered or tampered with in any way or manner. If for any reason the anchoring system becomes altered from the original installation, usage of the unit must stop immediately and the Lessee must call the Lessor at the number above.

(h) Participants shall be kept away from the blower(s) used to inflate the Unit. In the event that the blower is accidentally turned off, remove all participants from the Unit and turn on the blower. Do not allow the participants to re-enter the Unit until the Unit has been fully inflated. (i) All Units have been equipped with a zipper designed for quick deflation of the Unit at the time of pick up. Do not allow any participants to open the zipper. In the event that the zipper has been opened, remove all participants from the Unit and close the zipper. Do not allow the participants to re-enter the Unit until the Unit has been fully inflated. (j) Keep the Unit and the blower at least 15 feet away from swimming pools or other sources of water. (k) Do not allow participants to jump while holding on to the netting on the Unit.

(l) In addition to the aforementioned rules, all persons using this unit must obey all of the rules described on the Safety Rules sign attached to the unit.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING: The blower motor remains plugged in while Unit is in use. If Unit deflates, evacuate Unit calmly, there is no immediate threat if involuntary deflation occurs. Once participants are safely evacuated, check to make sure the motor is on and plugged in. Check the circuit breaker. Make sure nothing is blocking the air intake of the blower motor. Check the air tubes for tightness. If you still experience difficulties, please call the above number.

5. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES BY LESSEE: Lessee represents and warrants that, (a) He/she will fully read this agreement and have been instructed and fully understand the safe operation of the Unit. Lessee shall observe all safety precautions contained herewith, including but not limited to constant supervision of participants. (b) He/she shall keep the Unit in the same condition as when received. (c) He/she accepts responsibility for any damages to the Unit that occur from usage. (d) He/she agrees to reimburse Lessor for the cost to repair any damages that occur from usage. (e) He/she shall be responsible for the safe return of the Unit to Lessor through Lessor's agent who delivers and pick up the Unit. Lessor shall only allow the same person to deliver and pick up the Unit unless otherwise made known to Lessee by Lessor directly. In the event that the Unit is not safely returned, Lessee shall pay Lessor the full market value of the Unit. (f) He/she will follow the instructions under Section 3 hereunder. (g) He/she will not remove the Unit from the Event Location. (h) He/she will not make any alterations or attachments to the Unit. (i) He/she has received the Unit in good working order and condition.

6. DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES; LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: Lessor makes not warranties or representations, either express or implied, with respect to the Unit under this agreement, all of which are hereby disclaimed and excluded by Lessor, including without limitation any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose or use. In no event will Lessor be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, or consequential, damages of any character arising out of or in connection with the use of the Unit, including, without limitation, any damages arising out of personal injuries while using the Unit.

7. TITLE: Lessee shall keep the Unit in his/her custody at all times and shall not sublease, rent, sell, remove from the Event Location, or otherwise transfer the Unit. The Unit shall remain the property of the Lessor and may only be removed by Lessor or Lessor's agent after the "To" time as specified above.

8. INDEMNIFICATION; RELEASE OF LIABILITY: The Lessee shall have the full responsibility of the Unit's operation, including but not limited to supervision of the participants in the Unit. Lessor and its officers, employees and agents shall not be responsible for any injuries incurred during the use of the Unit. Lessee further agrees to hold Lessor and its officers, employees and agents free and harmless against any injuries or claim, the Lessee shall indemnify and hold harmless the Lessor and its officers, employees and agents from and against any costs incurred due to claims arising out of or in connection with the use and safe return of the Unit.

9. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This Rental Agreement constitutes the full agreement between Lessor and Lessee. The receipt of the Lessor's Unit that is the subject of this agreement is in good working order and repair and this is so acknowledged by Lessee.

10. WEATHER POLICY: In the event of rain, high wind or other causes outside the control of Lessor, Lessor reserves the right to terminate this Agreement and cancel the reservation hereunder.
