Environmental Site Assessment of a site at the Charles M. Schultz Airport, Sonoma County, CA where there is a WWII era hangar to be vacated by the Sonoma Jet Center and redeveloped and then occupied by Aerocrafters, Inc. The WWII hangar was part of the original US Navy Air Training Facility. Former uses included aircraft maintenance and fueling operations. Our scope of work was to conduct a Phase 1 ESA in compliance with the US-EPA's All Appropriate Inquiry (AAI) standards and ASTM E 1527-00 Standards, at that time. Based on evidence discovered we conducted a Phase 2 subsurface investigation, identified areas of contamination from former uses, and managed the Phase 3 remedial operations, waste

disposal and reporting, through Phase 4 case closure and redevelopment approval.
