

FAMILY ACTIVITIES

We have children's playground, horseshoe pits, or enjoy swimming off our sand beach. If you enjoy golfing, Ear Falls has a nine - hole golf course that many of our guests take an afternoon off to play. The forest around us offers a variety of wild berries, ripe for the picking when they are in season ... wild blueberries, strawberries or raspberries. Or you might just want to relax on our sundeck. GUIDING SERVICES

We hire experienced guides who are familiar with Lac Seul and its fisheries and have spent many years fishing on Lac Seul. They are not required but are available by the day or week. Advanced reservation is suggested.

WHITEWING'S WATER

All your water at Whitewing comes from a deep well that goes far down into rock to springs and you will know by the coldness and the refreshing taste you are drinking spring water. Our water is tested by our health department and has always tested pure. Many of our new guests bring bottles of water but, after tasting our water, end up refilling their bottles from our well.

THINGS TO BRING

Life jackets are mandatory, minnow buckets, dip nets, coolers, rain gear, cameras.

For Houseboats: Sleeping bags or blankets, bath linens, paper towels, toilet tissue.

RESERVATIONS

To secure the dates of your choice, it is necessary to reserve your trip as soon as possible. All cabin packages require a \$100.00 deposit per person and a deposit of \$1000.00 is required to reserve houseboats via credit card to hold reservation. Payment in full will be required at check-in and a credit card will need to be on file for incidentals.

The balance of your trip must be paid for in U.S. cash, Travelers Checkes, Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Interac (debt card). Any customer paying via credit card will be charged a 4% processing fee. Upon receiving your deposit, you will be promptly sent information for your date and receipt for your deposit. We cannot offer refunds for late arrivals, early departures, no-shows or reduced party size, so please be sure to notify us of any changes. 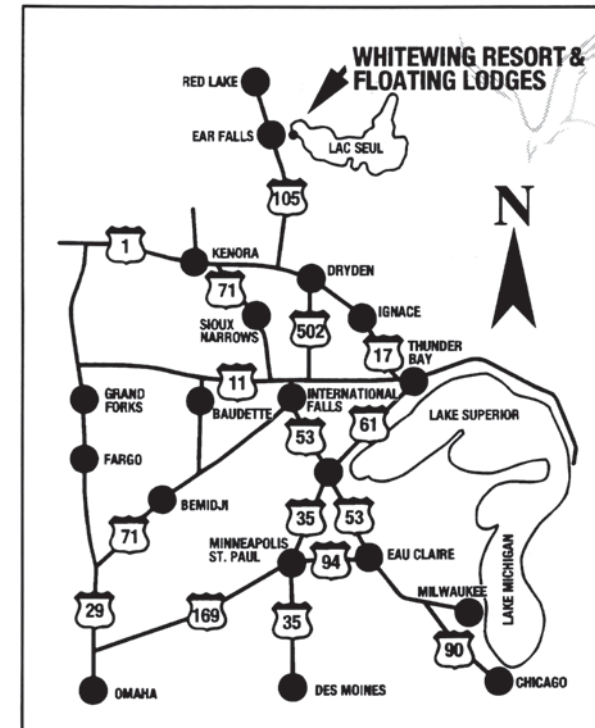

HOW TO REACH WHITEWING RESORT

If you are entering Ontario through International Falls - Fort Frances, follow Hwy. 11 east from Fort Frances to Hwy. 502, then north to Dryden. Once in Dryden, take Hwy. 17 west to Vermillion Bay, turn north on Hwy. 105 and go 60 miles. We are five miles south of Ear Falls. OR ...

In Fort Frances, you can take Hwy. 11 west to Hwy. 71 through Nestor Falls and Sioux Narrows to Hwy. 17 near Kenora. Take Hwy. 17 east to Vermillion Bay. Take Hwy. 106 north 60 miles. Again, we are five miles south of Ear Falls. Distances _____

HOUSEBOATS

Our houseboats are 16' x 65' with 2 bathrooms, one shower and sleep up to 12 people comfortably.

Houseboat plan includes: generator, propane stove, fridge, BBQ, fish cooker, heaters, microwave, coffee maker, toaster, all dishes and cookware, pillows, pillow cases and bottom sheet, one 15 cu. ft. freezer, one 16' aluminum boat (motor not included but available to rent).

Houseboat and guide boat gas is not included in rental. Gas will be refilled when boat is returned to dock to be added to final bill.

Houseboats with up to 8 people.... \$ 3,700.00 per week

Each additional person above 8..... \$ 400.00 per week

Houseboat guide required in and out \$ 150.00 each way and will be paid separately to the boats captain.

Private gas is not allowed to be transported or used in any of Whitewing's equipment.

Check - in time for Houseboats is 10:00 a.m. Saturday morning and check - out time is 5:00 p.m. Friday evening.

A deposit of \$1000.00 is required to reserve houseboats. Payment in full will be required at check-in and a credit card will be held on file for incidentals.

NO REFUNDS OR TRANSFERS

Rates are quoted in U.S. funds and are subject to Ontario sales tax H.S.T. Rates and exchange could change without notice.

Cabin Packages A, B, C Plan includes, 30 gals of gas per boat per week, 20 doz. minnows per boat per week, electric plug in at dock and complimentary ice. Cabins have electric stove and fridge, microwave, toaster, coffee maker, dishes and cookware, Kleenex, toilet tissue, kitchen linens, hand soap, flat screen TV, DVD player, garbage bags, propane BBQ and fish cooker on deck. Fresh bath linens are provided daily and garbage is picked up daily. You will have use of our screened fish house with freezer and wrapping, and ice supplied for your coolers and cottage.

CABINS

Cabins # 1, 2, 3, & 7 – Two bedrooms, one bath with deck or screened porch, kitchen, living room. (4 twin beds)

Cabins # 4 & 5– Three bedrooms, one bath with deck, large kitchen, dining room, living room, and patio doors. (6 twin beds)

Cabin # 6 – Five bedrooms, two baths with deck, large dining room, kitchen and living area. (12 twin beds)

Cabin # 8 – Three bedroom, one loft, two bath three story large log cabin overlooking lake, large wrap around deck, large dining, kitchen and living area. (8 twin beds)

ALL PACKAGES REQUIRE A \$100.00 DEPOSIT PER PERSON VIA CREDIT CARD TO HOLD RESERVATION. Payment in full will be required at check-in and a credit card will need to be on file for incidentals.

Children Ages – 0-10 Free, 10-16, \$275 Proof of age required.

No gas, boat and motor, or minnows are included in children's price.

Plan A- 2 people per boat

Weekly rate of \$770 US dollars per person will include: 18' Lund with 40 hp 4 stroke motor.

Short Stay-4 nights/3days \$460 US dollars per person is offered from July to October.

Plan A- 3 people per boat

Weekly rate of \$700 US dollars per person will include: 18' Lund with 40 hp 4 stroke motor.

Short Stay-4 nights/3days \$440 US dollars per person is offered from July to October.

Plan B- 2 people per boat

Weekly rate of \$800 US dollars per person will include: 18' Lund with 60 hp 4 stroke motor.

Short Stay-4 nights/3days \$480 US dollars per person is offered from July to October.

Plan B- 3 people per boat

Weekly rate of \$730 US dollars per person will include: 18' Lund with 60 hp 4 stroke motor.

Short Stay-4 nights/3days \$460 US dollars per person is offered from July to October.

Plan C- Private Boat

Weekly rate of \$600 US dollars per person

Short Stay-4 nights/3days \$400 US dollars per person is offered from July to October.

Guests are responsible for all damage and loss to Whitewing's property or equipment.

Guests under age 16, by law, are not allowed to operate boats with motors.

BOAT AND MOTOR RENTALS

The rental of our boats and motors includes gas tank, paddles and safety kits. Please bring your own life jackets as they are MANDATORY for everyone in Ontario.

Private gas is not allowed in our equipment. PER DAY PER WEEK

You can purchase your fishing license enroute, or in Ear Falls (5 miles).

We offer a full service campground for R.V.s (water, sewer and electric) as well as tenting. Our bathhouse has indoor showers and flushing toilets. You will have use of all camp facilities including fish house with freezer and wrapping. Private Boat launching, landing and firewood is available.
