

During runway construction, the Sonoma County Permits and Resources Department (PRMD) discovered that a gasoline UST was removed by the grading contractor without a permit and with no documentation. EGS was retained by the City of Petaluma to negotiate with the Sonoma County Environmental Health Division (SCEHD) to prepare an acceptable Work Plan to discover as much verifiable information about the UST as possible, conduct a soil and groundwater exploration program to determine if contamination was present, install monitoring wells, conduct remedial excavation of impacted soils, and conduct a multi-hydrologic cycle groundwater monitoring program. During the course of the project we coordinated with the City representatives, the Airport Manager, the County, and regulatory agencies. Upon Completion of the work we obtained Case Closure for the Petaluma Municipal Airport.
