In accordance with County and State requirements, all data for a site with an environmental investigation is required to be uploaded to the California State Geotracker database. EGS obtains authorization from our Clients to be designated as the Authorized Representative for the site, and certifies that the applicable state regulatory requirements pursuant to Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 30 of the California Code of Regulations, will be complied with. The State of California requires all information related to contaminated sites to be uploaded to the State Geotracker database.

EGS converts and uploads to the State database required files including well location data (Geo\_XY and Geo\_Z), boring logs (Geo\_Bore), maps (Geo\_Maps), well elevation data (Geo\_Well), laboratory analytical reports (EDF files), and technical information including work plans, reports, correspondence, etc, pertaining to the site investigation. Keeping our clients in compliance with GeoTracker requirements is one of the many services our experienced staff provides as part of keeping projects on track to closure. This is one of several ways EGS adds value to our scope of services.
